##### ACQUISITION OF LAND

The Government of Tamil Nadu having been satisfied that the lands specified in the Schedule below and situated Adyar Village, Mambalam-Guindy Taluk, Chennai District have to be acquired for a public purpose, and it having already been decided that the entire amount of compensation to be awarded for the lands is to be paid out of funds provided by the Chennai Metro Rail Limited, the following declaration is issued under Section 6 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (Central Act I of 1894).

##### DECLARATION

Under Section 6 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (Central Act I of 1894) the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby declares that the land specified in the Schedule below and measuring 1 Ground 1335 Square feet (or) 3735 Square feet be the same a little more or less are needed for public purpose to wit, for the implementation of Chennai Metro Rail Project. Under sub-section (1) of Section 17 of the

said Act, the Governor of Tamil Nadu further directs that the possession of the said lands may be taken on the expiry of 15 days from the date of publication of the notice mentioned in Section 9(1) of the Act.

A Plan of lands is kept in the office of the Special Tahsildar (Land Acquisition), Chennai Metro Rail Limited, Chennai Unit-I, Harini Towers, No. 7, Conran Smith Road, Gopalapuram, Chennai-86 and may be inspected at any time during office hours.
