## Prohibition against carriage of dangerous and offensive material

No person shall take or cause to be taken on the metro railway any of the following dangerous materials, namely:-

- (a) Explosive substances which possess risk of explosion or fire or both;
- (b) Gases compressed, liquefied or dissolved under pressure;
- (c) Petroleum and other inflammable liquids;
- (d) Inflammable solids;
- (e) Oxidizing substances;
- (f) Poisonous (toxic) substances;
- (g) Acids and other corrosives;
- (h) Radioactive substances;
- (i) Weapons, arms and ammunitions.
- (j) Any Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear and Enhanced Conventional Weapons which possess risk to passengers or property.

## No person shall take or cause to be taken on the metro railway any of the following offensive

## Materials, namely:-

- (a) Blood dried or coagulated or decomposed, whether human or animal;
- (b) Corpses;
- (c) Carcasses of dead animals or of dead birds;
- (d) Bones excluding bleached and cleaned bones;
- (e) Human skeleton;
- (f) Parts of human body;
- (g) Portable radio devices which possess risk to radio communication network and communication based traffic control signaling network;

No person shall take or cause to be taken on the metro railway live animals or birds:

<u>Provided that a security person on duty may take along sniffer dog for the purpose of security.</u>
