

CHENNAI TO GET THREE MORE FLYOVERS

Three flyovers will be constructed in Chennai -- one above Ganesapuram subway, second at the intersection of Konnur High Road -- Strahans Road and third at South Usman road, all three projects at the estimated cost of Rs 335 crore.

INFRA BOOST FOR CITIES

- 27 cities with a population of above one lakh will be fully covered with underground sewage systems.
- All unpaved roads in municipalities and town panchayats will be paved. Pedestrian friendly and differently abled friendly streets will be created in all urban areas.
- An integrated bus stand cum commercial centre will be established in Tiruchirapalli with the financial assistance of TUFIDCO.

- Rs.500 crore has been provided for Singara Chennai 2.0.
- Underground sewage systems will be provided to all the added areas of Chennai city at a total cost of Rs.2,056 crore. The scheme to prevent outflow of sewage into waterways in Chennai will be vigorously implemented at a total cost of Rs.2,371 crore.

- A feasibility report would be prepared for transmitting Krishna water through pipelines from Andhra Pradesh to the reservoirs of Chennai.

- Services on Kodambakkam to Poonamallee bypass section of the metro rail project will be commenced within four years, by June, 2025 and the entire Metro Rail Project Phase II will be completed by December, 2026.

- The government will speedily take up the extension of the metro rail project from the airport to Kilambakkam bus terminus via Tambaram.
