CMRL to install solar lights at staff quarter premises

Chennai: Metro rail will be installing solar street lights at their staff quarter premises at Koyambedu in an effort to maximise the use of renewable energy.

It has invited tenders to supply and install 50watt solar street lights. This will be in addition to the solar street lights installed at various metro stations and the solar

Metro rail has already taken efforts to increase the use

of green energy and reduce its electricity consumption by first installing solar panels in administrative office at Koyambedu. The photovoltaic panels with an installed capacity of 1MW generates over 5000 units a day and is being used to power electrical systems in the administrative office and for train maintenance work at the depot. Officials said the installation was expected to save more than ₹1.12 crores eve-

ry year for CMRL.
As many as 25 locations with a total area of more than 1.4 lakh square metres were identified for the purpose.
