Metro rail job racket: CCB arrests web designer, asst

Chennai: More arrests have been made in connection with a job racket misusing the name and symbol of Chennai Metro Rail Limited (CMRL). On Monday, the Central Crime Branch of the city police arrested two people, including a web designer and his assistant for creating two fake websites - with the doman names chennalmetrorail.org and www.cmrlco.org - to con iob-aspirants.

The arrest was made after the confession of Sreejith, 34 of Mallapuram in Kerala, who masterminded and created the two fake websites targeting prospective candidates. He was arrested on July 8, Police nabbed web designer

NBalu, 38, of West Mambalam and his assistant B Prashanth, 32, of Ernavur on Monday. The arrested duo was remanded in judicial custody after being produced before a magistrate court in the city.

The arrests came after Chennai Metro Rail Ltd officials lodged a police complaint seeking action against people who had created a fake website in the name of the transit agency and were cheating job aspirants.

They had earlier cautioned prospective job candidates not to fall prey to fake and misleading advertisements that cheats claim CMRL is airing on local television channels and hosting on social me-

dia platforms.
