Feeder services find more takers

As many as 28,000 passengers used the shared auto and shared car service of the Chennai Metro last month.

Officials said the number of people using these services grew by about 10,000 when compared to the previous month – when it was started to help passengers with last-mile connectivity.

Nearly 24,000 people are using shared auto services and about 4,800 people take the shared car services.

Shared auto services operate in Guindy, Thirumangalam, Alandur, Little Mount, Ekkatuthangal, Koyambedu, St. Thomas Mount and Ashok Nagar stations for ₹10 and share car in AG-DMS, Anna Nagar East, Koyambedu, Alandur and Vadapalani stations for ₹15 respectively.

Chennai Metro Rail plans to take these facilities to all stations.
