
Solar plant set up at Koyambedu stn

TO achieve energy security and promote use of green energy, Chennai Metro Rail has installed a 410 KW solar plant at its Koyambedu station at different spots, including rooftop and ground area. The plant is expected to generate around 55,350 units per month and CMRL will be saving around

MW in total," said a press release. Another 5.5 MW Roof Top Solar Power installation is under progress and is expected to be completed by the end of this year.
