CMRL successfully installed and commissioned another 103 KWp Roof Top Solar PV Power System

CMRL being very much committed to achieve energy security, to reduce carbon emission and Green energy concept by generating renewable energy by installing Roof Top Solar PV Power System in different premises of Roof Top area in sheds of Metro Rail depot situated at Koyambedu, Elevated and Under Ground Metro Stations.

CMRL successfully installed and commissioned another 103 KWp Roof Top Solar PV Power System in ancillary buildings of four Under Ground Metro Stations namely Thirumangalam, Anna Nagar Tower, Anna Nagar East and Shenoy Nagar Metro Stations which is expected to generate around 13800 units per month and saves around Rs.6,34,744 lakhs per year.

This method of Generated Solar Power will be utilized for technical demands. Now the installed capacity of Roof Top Solar Power by CMRL is 1.6 MW in total. Another 6.0 MW Roof Top Solar Power installation is under progress and is expected to be completed by the end of this year 2018.

Chennai Metro Rail Project – Dengue Awareness Program in all Underground and System Packages.



Chennai Metro Rail works are in progress at different parts of the city. Twenty-six stations have been completed and commissioned for operation as on October 2018 which consists of both Elevated and Underground Stations. Works are on-going in the balance underground stations and associated tunnels. Around 5000 laborers are engaged in the project, with high intensity works being carried out in the project in both day and night shifts the labors are exposed to climate fatigue and illness on account of other epidemic viral diseases.

To protect the workmen, regular health checkup and health awareness camps are conducted for all workers at the site location and labour camps. Stagnant water at work sites and labor camps are cleared periodically, fogging and chemical spraying are done throughout the work location and labor camps and food waste is disposed on a regular basis and not allowed to accumulate. Contractors are given instructions to give regular awareness on this to all in their site, regular inspection and audits of work sites and labor camps are conducted by CMRL representatives with contractors to ensure systematic housekeeping and prevent water stagnation.





To create Awareness on Dengue, CMRL project has taken extra efforts to protect its workers from the deadly diseases. The workers are given special training at site locations on vector control diseases, its implications and steps to be taken to control the same. Doctors were present to explain about the seriousness of the disease and awareness videos were played for better understanding. Laborers were given Nilavembu Kashayam for the prevention of dengue. The distribution of Nilavembu Kashayam is done regularly at work sites and labor camps.

CMRL Mobile App update for better Travel Planning and Easy Travel Card Recharge

The CMRL Mobile app launched last year received a positive response with over 50,000 downloads in 3 months. An update released on 1st October 2018, would simplify the CMRL Travel Card recharge process and provide commuters with live train timings. Users can register on the app and store up to 5 travel cards for easy recharge up to Rs.1000/- per card per transaction. After recharge, the users will have to follow the current process of visiting the station for updating the card balance at the Ticket Vending Machine (TVM). Commuters can now plan their commute down to the minute by checking the exact time of arrival of a train as the train timings are provided on real time basis.

Other major updates on the app include Feedback section, Travel Planner and Feeder Service information. The Feedback feature will now allow commuters to submit their feedback in real time to CMRL authorities. Chennai Metro Rail has 2 lines that connect various suburbs of the city. Commuters would also not have the dilemma of having to identify interchange stations to reach their destination. The updated travel planner would let the passenger know if the train they are about to board is a direct train or if they need to interchange at Alandur. It also provides them the list of stations in between. In other words, the app is now a comprehensive guide to navigate when using the Chennai Metro.

Commuters will be able to view the feeder service (bus, cab and auto) available at different stations to surrounding areas. The upgrade of the CMRL Mobile App is available for Android and the iOS version.

FEEDER SERVICES



As part of providing last mile connectivity to Metro Rail In addition to already existing last mile connectivity to Metro passengers, CMRL had taken an initiative of providing Feeder services through Share auto and Share Taxi services at selected Metro Stations on trial basis for a period of six months from 11.08.2018. Eight Metro Stations were identified for Share Auto Feeder service. The Share Auto Feeder services are running on the designated feeder routes with a flat tariff of Rs. 10. Similarly, the Share Taxi Feeder services are planned for five selected Metro Stations. The Share Taxi Feeder services are covering an area up to 3 Km radius with a flat tariff of Rs. 15.

For the month of October 2018, a total of 28,032 passengers have utilized the Share Auto and Share Taxi facilities in which 6,442 passengers have utilized the Share Taxi services and a total of 21,590 passengers have utilized the Share Auto services.

In addition to this CMRL introduced last mile connectivity for the benefit of Metro Passengers between Alandur Metro Station to DLF cyber city IT Park. Currently four Air Conditioned tempo travelers are plying between Alandur to DLF at an interval of 15 Minutes with a flat rate of Rs. 20/-.

The Feeder Services were inaugurated by Thiru L Narasim Prasad, Director (Systems and Operations), CMRL and Tmt. Uma R Krishnan ,CEO of Barclays inaugurated the feeder services from Alandur Metro Station on 1.10.2018 at Alandur Metro Station and at DLF IT Park, Porur, Chennai.

This Tempo Traveller is running on the route from Alandur Metro Station to DLF via L&T Office with a frequency of every 15 minutes on weekdays.

During weekend days (Saturday and Sunday), the same service will take two routes, which are from Alandur Metro Station to DLF Via L&T Office to Saravana Stores- SRM Easwari Engineering College - Alandur Metro and from Alandur Metro Station to Phoenix Mall Via ITC grand, Velachery Main road both with a frequency of every 30 minutes at a flat rate of Rs. 20/-.

The new route for the share taxi services at AG-DMS will be:

AG-DMS-Spencer plaza-Express Avenue-Royapettah Govt Hospital-Avvai Shanmugam Road- AG-DMS and is available on call basis. Passengers can use the CMRL Customer service number - 1860 - 4251 - 1515 for booking the Share Taxi services at a flat rate of Rs. 15/-.

The Feeder Services are available between 6:30 am and 9:30 pm during the Metro Rail operational hours. Based on the acceptance and improvement, the same kind of service will be introduced in other metro stations.

Feeders Services for Infosys:

Infosys Buses have been introduced from Alandur Metro Station to Mahendra City and Sholinganallur campus. A total of 6 trips are made in the morning, with 3 trips made each campus every day.

Rail Stations, Several Bi-Cycle Schemes have been introduced at CMRL Metro stations for the benefit of the passengers and to promote a healthier and sustainable mode of transport.

Bi-Cycle Scheme

CMRL has introduced Bi-cycles for Last Mile Connectivity on Free of Cost with a refundable Deposit of Rs. 3000/-. So far 95 Cycles are introduced at all 26 Metro Stations. A GPS enabled bi-cycle scheme by PEDL Bi-cycle Scheme by Zoom Car from October 2017 at 3 Metro Stations namely Thirumangalam, Anna Nagar tower, Anna Nagar East and 100 hours of free rides bi-cycle scheme by Athi's Cycles from October 2017 at 6 Metro Stations namely Nehru park, Shenoy Nagar, Anna Nagar East, Thirumangalam, Vadapalani, Ashok Nagar have been provided at various underground and elevated metro stations have garnered an over whelming response from the Chennai Public for the above schemes.

Mini Bus by MTC services are also available at Metro stations as last mile connectivity. The buses are available at Koyambedu, Ashok Nagar, CMBT, Alandur, Guindy, Nehru Park, and Central Metro Stations.

Bike Rental:

Bikes are available for hire at metro stations for the convenience of passengers for the last mile connectivity. These Facilities are available at Thirumangalam, Shenoy Nagar, Egmore, and Airport Metro Stations.

Apart from the above, Buggy services are available at Airport & Vadapalani and Walkalator connecting Airport Metro Station and Chennai Airport are also available for the benefit of the passengers.
