Chennai: As Chennai Metro Rail Ltd. (CMRL) is gearing up to open the last leg of phase-1 by the end of January, it has started looking for a company to augment the maintenance of its critical sys-

tems at its stations and depot. CMRL has floated a tender for maintenance of services of signalling systems, platform screen doors at stations, administration building, operation control centre, viaduct, tunnels, trains, de-

pots and other related premises. According to the tender invite, the contractor will have to maintain these critical systems for a duration of five years. The agency has floated the tender at a time when it has been facing frequent technical glitches including those caused by a corrupted signal software.
