Commuters and passersby can fill their bottles or
drink glasses of water at the
plant free of cost. The plant
has been installed on the street level near one of the entrances of the transit hub, linking
two corridors of phase-I. It is
easily accessible to passengers from the suburban railway station, Central railway
station, MTC bus stand and
metro station.

"We chose the location for installation based on the movement of passengers. The plant will give purified drinking water," an official said. CMRL officials said similar plants will be installed at other metro stations soon.
