3.81 crore passengers have travelled in Chennai Metro Rail from 29th June 2015 to 14 th May 2019



CMRL commenced its Metro Train operations from 29th June 2015 and has become the lifeline for the people of Chennai. Come rain or shine, CMRL has always endeavored to provide the people of Chennai a safe, efficient and a reliable travel partner for its loyal commuters.

As part of providing world class infrastructure facilities to the people of Chennai, CMRL has come up with several efficient and sustainable initiatives to increase the patronage such as citing availability of parking space at Metro Stations and launching many last mile connectivity measures. like Share Auto, Share Taxi services which are presently available at few metro stations will soon have at all 32 Metro stations.

An incremental increase in the ridership was witnessed by CMRL since the commencement of Metro Train operations. So far a total of 3, 81, 03,799 passengers have travelled in Chennai Metro Between 29th June 2015 and 14th May 2019

The ridership has touched to a mark of 1, 02,790 passengers on 26th April 2019. And a total of 92,917 passengers have travelled on 6th May 2019 and 95,119 passengers have travelled on 10th May 2019.



RO Drinking Water Plant Installed – For Public Use – at Central Metro Station

As part of providing world class infrastructure facilities to the people of Chennai City, CMRL installed RO Drinking Water Plant holding 500 litres capacity at Central Metro Station for the public at free of cost.

The plant has been installed near an entrance at street level of Central Metro Rail Station which is the main junction comprising Suburban Park Station entrance, Puratchi Thalaivar Dr. M.G. Ramachandran Central Railway Station Subway, Chennai Metro Rail entrance and Main Road Bus stand location where all the three different modes train passengers meet.







CMRL has installed the RO Drinking Water Plant at the above location so that the maximum number of people can utilise the purified drinking water especially during the hot summer seasons.

CMRL has planned to install the similar kind of plants at some more Metro Rail Stations in near future.

44,940 passengers have utilized the Share Auto and Share Taxi facilities at the metro rail stations in the month of April 2019



CMRL had taken an initiative of providing several Last Mile Connectivity measures for the Metro Passengers among which Share auto and Share Taxi Feeder services are plying at selected Metro Rail Stations on a trial basis since 11.08.2018.

A total of Seven Metro Stations were identified for Share Auto Feeder service. The Share Auto Feeder services are running on the designated feeder routes with a flat tariff of Rs.5. Similarly, the Share Taxi Feeder services are planned for six select Metro Rail Stations. The Share Taxi Feeder services are covering an area up to 3 Km radius with a flat tariff of Rs.10.

A total of 44,940 passengers have utilized the Share Auto and Share Taxi facilities at the metro rail stations in the month of April 2019. In which, 6,260 passengers have utilized the Share Taxi services and a total of 38,680 no's of passengers have utilized the Share Auto Services

Around 3, 03,795 passengers have availed the Share Auto and Share Taxi feeder services from 11th of August 2018 to 30th of April 2019.

Educational trips for 31,178 students from Government and Corporation Schools provided in the academic year 2018-19
