MTC launches feeder service from 3 more Metro stations

CHENNAL: As part of improving lastmile connectivity, the Metropolitan Transport Corporation (MTC) has introduced small bus feeder services from LIC, AG-DMS and **Washermenpet Metro Rail stations** from Monday.

A statement from the MTC said that in order to provide connectivity to the Chennai Metro stations that were opened in the last phase, it has launched 11 small bus services on five routes. This is in addition to 30 small buses operated in 13 routes in various Metro stations in the city.
