# CMRL Bio STP - waste water recycling plant (without electricity) completes one year successfully

CMRL Bio STP - waste water recycling plant (without electricity) has completed its one year successfully. CMRL, an integral part of Chennaities life over two years, has contributed in easing transportation in the ever-growing city's travel chaos. Adding another feather to its cap, CMRL had launched another green initiative "Bio-sewage treatment plant" without electricity at CMBT Metro station with the anaerobic sewage treatment plant for 10 KLD capacity on June 05, 2018 – the "World Environment Day".

This Green initiative too has been a trend-setter! Having convinced of its utility, CMRL considers this as an ideal solution to city's mushrooming multi-level residential complexes as an affordable, economical, nonrecurring maintenance and not the least, saving on electricity and water! It's a boon to sanitation!

Chennai Metro Rail had executed a Pilot project of Bio Sewage treatment plant, which does not require electricity to run the plant since last year June 5th, 2018 on World Environment Day and now the plant has thus been successfully running for past one year and saved huge water.

It is big boon for the builders & Residential apartments where the residents suffer due to lack of knowledge of STP operation and huge wear and tear cost on machineries.

In addition to this, CMRL has also launched another anaerobic sewage treatment plant installation at Guindy Metro Station with a total capacity of 10 KLD which is in progress. An existing 75 KLD capacity plant at CMRL Depot is being enhanced to 150 KLD for the benefit of its staff quarters at the Depot premises and installation is in progress.





### 45,494 passengers have utilized the Share Auto and Share Taxi services in the Month of May 2019

CMRL had taken an initiative of providing several Last Mile Connectivity measures for the Metro Passengers among which Share auto and Share Taxi Feeder services are plying at selected Metro Rail Stations on a trial basis since 11.08.2018.

A total of Seven Metro Stations were identified for Share Auto Feeder service. The Share Auto Feeder services are running on the designated feeder routes with a flat tariff of Rs.5. Similarly, the Share Taxi Feeder services are planned for six select Metro Rail Stations.

The Share Taxi Feeder services are covering an area up to 3 Km radius with a flat tariff of Rs.10.

Similarly a total of 45,494 passengers have utilized the Share Auto and Share Taxi facilities at the metro rail stations in the month of May 2019. So far, total of 3,49,289 number of passengers have utilized the Share Auto and Share Taxi facilities between 11th Aug 2018 and 31st May 2019.
