

Metro Rail increases frequency of trains

Chennai: To cater to its expanding patronage, Chennai Metro Rail has increased the frequency of trains in all corridors as part of the functional phase one metro rail project. Previously, there was a train for every seven minutes in the blue line and every 14 minutes in the green line. From Monday (August 26) onwards, trains will be plying every five minutes in the blue corridor from Washermanpet to Airport via LIC, and every 10 minutes in the green corridor from Chennai Central to St Thomas Mount and Inter-corridor from Chennai Central to Airport, during the peak hours, 8 am to 11 am and 5 pm to 8 pm on weekdays. Old schedule will apply for holidays and weekends, said a release. ENS
