Metro rail services to continue, with heightened security

A ride on the metro rail's elevated corridor may give Chennaiites a chance to watch Chinese President Xi Jinping leaving Chennai Airport for his hotel in Guindy, as the train services will not be stopped during arrival of the delegates. But commuters will be rigorously frisked and their baggage scanned at all metro stations between Airport and Guindy. A metro rail official said security will be stepped up inside metro stations like Airport with the existing state and private security force assigned to CMRL. The state police force will take control of the area outside the stations.
