

Electric scooters for ₹1/minute

Fly Rental Service has brought in keyless, eco-friendly scooters at the Alandur Metro station, said a release. The initiative is likely to be expanded to other stations as well.

Passengers can use the Fly App, available on Google Play, to book these vehicles. Passengers have to pay ₹1 a minute to use these electric scooters.

The vehicles will be available from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m., the release said. Currently,

there are six such scooters at the Alandur Metro station. Chennai Metro plans to increase their number to

15, if the demand goes up.

Sometime back, Metro had joined hands with Vogo, and electric scooters were made available for passengers at the Guindy and Alandur Metro stations. The Metro also has cycles at many of its stations, including Nehru Park, Kilpauk, Shenoy Nagar, Alandur, Little Mount and Thirumangalam.
