Chennai Metro suspends biometric attendance system

CHENNAI: As part of coronavirus precautionary measures, Chennai Metro has suspended bio-metric attendance system and asked its officials and staffs to register their attendance through register.

In addition, for the benefit of Metro commuters antivirus precautionary messages are being sent as SMS to their cell phones. "Do's and don'ts are published at all Metro stations along with the announcements which are regularly made for benefit of the passengers," an official release from

the CMRL said.

The Metro set to undertake disinfectant activity at Airport station on Sunday in association with Ascentva Research Development Solutions. It said CMRL had carried out a disinfectant activity at Central Metro Station on Saturday against spread of COVID -19 (coronavirus) in the collaboration with Ascentya Research and Development Solutions Ltd. It said that the disinfectant activity will be conducted on Sunday at Airport Metro station after the revenue hours at 11pm.
