

Metro rail lights up two stations

Chennai: Taking inspiration from structures like India Gate and Rashtrapati Bhavan, metro rail has lit up the glass elevators and entrances at Central Metro and Government Estate stations.

Metro rail said it has installed façade wall washer lights that change colour every second inside the 12 glass elevators at Central Metro. Six entry points at the underground transit hub have also been lit up.

“Chennai Central metro station is an interconnecting hub and thousands of commuters walk around on the street level to access metro, suburban, mainline and MTC to reach their destination every day. CMRL decided to make this location iconic,” the release said. It said the lighting was inspired by landmarks like Canton Tower, China, Seoul Tower and Howrah Bridge. **TNN**
