

CMRL ends biometric attendance

Chennai Metro Rail Limited (CMRL) on Thursday temporarily suspended the biometric attendance system for its staff as a preventive measure against the spread of Covid-19.

Metro rail has instructed its staff to manually mark their attendance in a register instead. A week ago, the Centre had exempted all its employees from biometric attendance till October 31.

CMRL officials said they had taken a number of measures to raise awareness among its passengers about the spread of the coronavirus. As part of its measures, the Central metro and Airport metro stations will be sprayed with disinfectants this weekend. These two stations cater to a large numbers of outstation passengers.
