

3,567 use QR code tickets for metro rail travel: A total of 3,567 passengers purchased QR-code tickets, a newly launched facility to encourage contactless commute, for metro rail travel. The use of QR-code ticketing service, which allows passengers to buy tickets on CMRL mobile app, increased from 157 on September 7 to 465 on September 13 to 3,567 as on Wednesday morning. On Monday and Tuesday, an average of 16,100 passengers travelled in metro trains in Chennai. Until Monday, a total of 65,038 passengers had travelled in metro trains in Chennai since operations

resumed on September 7 after a break of five months.
