

Over 3.6L rode in Metro Rail in September

CHENNAI: Amid the Covid-19 pandemic, a total of 3,60,193 passengers travelled in the Chennai Metro Rail from September 7 to 30. According to a statement from the CMRL, on September 30 alone, a total of 22,065 passengers used the service. A total of 13,044 passengers utilised the recently launched QR-coded ticketing system while 70,009 passengers used the Travel Card Ticketing System. While a 10 per cent discount is already available for passengers using the travel cards, the CMRL has been giving 20 per cent discount on QR-coded tickets namely Single Journey QR Ticket, Return Journey QR Ticket, Group QR Ticket and QR Trip passes from 11-09-2020.
