Manifold increase in CMRL footfall

Chennai: In a manifold increase in patronage since the lockdown was relaxed, a total of 8.58 lakh passengers travelled in the Chennai Metro trains in November, According to a statement from the Chennai Metro Rail Limited (CMRL), a total of 3,60,193 passengers travelled in September after the services resumed, while the figure almost doubled to 7.03,223 in October, Meanwhile, a total of 19.21.962 passengers have taken the metro services so far since September, In November, a total of 21.579 passengers utilised the recently launched OR-code ticketing system. "Also, 4,72,027 passengers have used the Travel Card Ticketing System. CMRL offers a 20 per cent discount on OR-code ticketing for single journey, return journey, Group OR Ticket and OR Trip passes," the statement said. A 10 per cent discount is already available for passengers using travel cards. ENS
