

9,972 commuters used new metro line on Monday

A total of 9,972 passengers used the 9-km Washermenpet - Wimco Nagar line a day after it was inaugurated by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Sunday.

The highest footfall witnessed at the Wimco Nagar metro station with 1,727 while lowest in Tondiarpet Metro with 854. According to the Chennai Metro Rail Limited (CMRL), a total of 80,152 people used the metro service across the city on Monday.

In the green line, Central metro station witnessed the highest passenger flow of 7,562 followed by the Tirumangalam station with 4,320. In blue line, airport station topped with 4,791 while high court metro reached second 3,806. Nearly 35,000 people have travelled through both lines on the day.
