

CMRL honours 2 staff for saving life of passenger

The Chennai Metro Rail Limited has honoured two of its employees for saving the life of a passenger during a health emergency.

The incident happened on a train moving through Nehru Park-Egmore metro station stretch last Wednesday. Train operator P.M. Rajeev and Egmore metro station controller J.
