CMRL to run more services today

Chennai: CMRL will operate trains every five minutes from 7am to Ham and from 4pm to 8pm on Thursday, when transport workers' unions in Tamil Nadu are to begin their indefinite strike.

Usually, peak hours at metro stations are from 8am to 10am and 4pm to 7pm. CMRL will be operating more service on Thursday to help commuters who may find less buses on Chennai roads.

Trains will be operated at the increased peak hour frequency on both the corridors of phase-1 from Wimco Nagar to Airport and from Central Metro to St Thomas Mount.

In a release, CMRL said additional trips would be enabled during non-peak hours depending on the passenger flow. MNN
