₹200 fine for not wearing masks on metro trains

CMRL has been allowing passengers at the entry point only after ensuring that every passenger is properly wearing a face mask. However, some passengers, after crossing the screening point at metro entrance and while traveling on metro train, are not wearing the face mask or not properly wearing the mask, even though regular displays and public announcements are being made at metro stations and inside metro trains.

The fine shall be imposed by station controllers/CMRL staff deputed for this purpose at metro station premises and by a flying squad on metro trains, duly issuing a receipt from the penalty receipt booklet

Due to the surge in Covid cases, Government of Tamil Nadu has ordered a spot fine of ₹200 on anyone found without a face mask in public.

A fine of ₹200 will be collected if a passenger is

found not wearing a face mask or not properly wearing a face mask on metro station premises / while travelling in metro trains.

The fine shall be imposed by station controllers/CMRL staff deputed for this purpose at metro station premises and by a flying squad on metro trains, duly issuing a receipt from the penalty receipt booklet. The fine will be imposed from Sunday, according to a press release issued by the joint director / public relations officer, CMRL.
