

CMRL curbs Metro train operations on Sundays

EXPRESS FEATURES

CMRL has been undertaking adequate precautions at all Metro stations and in Metro trains by making it compulsory for everyone to wear face masks inside the Metro premises and Metro trains. Testing passengers using thermal scanner, cleaning of trains, ticketing places, entry and exit gates at frequent intervals, making available sanitizers at entry, liquid soaps in the rest room areas, displaying dos and don'ts to spread awareness and public announcements at stations and in trains are being strictly followed for curbing the spread of COVID-19.

Chennai Metro Rail Limited has decided to operate its Metro train services on all Sundays in the month of May 2021 as per the directive of Government of

Tamil Nadu for operating skeletal Metro rail services from 7 am till 9 pm. Metro train services will be available to passengers in the following headway schedule;

① Wimco Nagar to Airport **(Blue Line)**: one hour

② Puratchi Thalaivar Dr MG Ramachandran Central Metro to Airport Metro (via Arignar Anna Alandur Metro and Koyambedu) **(Green Line)**: two hours

③ Puratchi Thalaivar Dr MG Ramachandran Central Metro to St. Thomas Mount (via Arignar Anna Alandur Metro and Koyambedu) **(Green Line)**: two hours

There will be no peak-hour service (as per weekend Metro train schedule). Passengers are requested to maintain social distancing while waiting at stations and during their travelling in Metro trains.
