25.19 lakh passengers travelled in Chennai Metro Trains in January, 2022

CMRL has been operating its Metro Train Services with 50% capacity as per the instructions of Government of Tamil Nadu.

- A total of 25,19,252 passengers have travelled in the Metro Trains from 1st January 2022 to 31st January 2022.
- On 3rd January 2022 a maximum of 1,35,977 passengers have used the Metro Trains to commute.

In the month of January, 2022 a total of 74,879 passengers have utilized the QR Code ticketing system, while 14,60,655 passengers have used Travel Card Ticketing System. CMRL presently offers a 20% discount on QR Code ticketing (Single, Return, Group Tickets and Q.R Trip passes) from 11.09.2020. Additionally 20% discount fares are available on Metro Train Travel Cards from 22.02.2021.

Metro Train services will run from 5.30 am to 11.00 pm on weekdays from 28th January 2022

Following the cancellation of the lockdown by the Government of Tamil Nadu, the Chennai Metro will resume normal services from 28th January 2022 from 5.30 am to 11.00 pm on weekdays (Monday to Saturday) with existing peak hour services from 08:00 am to 11:00 am in the morning and from 05:00 pm to 08:00 pm in the evening with 5 minute headway during Peak hours and 10-minute headway during Non-peak hours.

Sunday Train Service Schedule:

Metro Train services will run on Sundays with existing train timing schedule from 07:00 am to 10:00 pm with

10 minutes headway throughout the day. There will be no peak hour service.

Holiday Train Service Schedule:

Metro Train services will run on Government Public Holidays, from 05:30 am to 11:00 pm instead of 7:00 am to 10:00 pm with 10 minutes headway throughout the day. And 10:00 pm to 11:00 pm with 15 minutes headway throughout the day. There will be no peak hour services in the Holiday Timetable Schedule.
