Chennai Metro Rail being the first Metro Rail System in India that connects Railway Terminals, Bus Terminals and Airport in the First Phase. Phase I

- · Consists of Blue Line and Green Line
- · Phase I covers 45 km with 32 Metro Stations (13 Elevated Stations and 19 Underground Stations)
- · The Blue Line (23.085 Km) from Washermanpet to Airport
- Green Line (21.961 km) from Puratchi Thalaivar Dr. M. G. Ramachandran Central to St. Thomas Mount.
- · Passengers have the feasibility to interchange between two Lines at Arignar Anna Alandur Metro (Elevated) and Puratchi Thalaivar Dr. M. G. Ramachandran Central Metro (Underground) to reach their desired destinations.
- The total of cost of construction of Phase-1 was ₹18380 Crores.
- · The Phase I of CMRL project was the first in India to directly connect to Airport in the first phase itself.

Phase I Extension

- · The Blue Line has been extended for a further 9.05 Kilometers Washermanpet to Wimco Nagar.
- · Covers 9 Metro Stations with 7 Elevated and 2 Underground Stations
- · Connects major Transport Hubs, Railway Stations, Ports, Shopping Malls, Government Offices and Hospitals.
- · The total of cost of construction of Phase I Extension was ₹ 3770 Cores

• CMRL's ambitious Phase II for a network of 118.9 km is a gargantuan feat undertaken at one stretch and a first of its kind in India with 128 stations at a cost of ₹63,246 crores. The project is approved by Government of Tamil Nadu. The approval for the project is awaited from Government of India. CMRL has ventured into an extensive infrastructure development in the city comprising of three more corridors,

by Government of India, Government of Tamil Nadu and JICA.

Financial Support: The Phase I and Phase II Extension were financially supported

• The Phase II consists of three corridors i.e. Corridor -3 - From Madhavaram to Sipcot (45.8 Km), Corridor -4 - From Lighthouse to Poonamalle Bypass (26.1 Km), Corridor-5-From Madhavaram to Sholinganallur (47 Km)

The estimated completion cost of the project is ₹63246 Crores.

 About 65% of the corridors in Phase II is elevated and the remaining is underground. The project is under implementation and expected to be completed by end of 2027

• The First TBM tunnel drive commenced from Madhavaram Milk Colony Station to Madhavaram High Road Station covering a bored tunnel length of 1.4 km. The first Tunnel Boring Machine was commenced by Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu, Thiru. M.K.Stalin on 13-10-2022 at Madhavaram Milk Colony Station.
