Chennai Metro Rail Administration: Repair Work on Arcot Road Progressing
Rapidly, Anticipated Completion within a Week

CHENNAI, TAMIL NADU, India – October 3, 2023 – The Chennai Metro Rail Administration (CMRL) today informed that repair work on Arcot Road, the main road connecting Porur, Vadapalani, and Kodambakkam, is progressing rapidly and is anticipating completion all of the repair works within a week.

CMRL contractor, Larsen & Toubro, is working on the road repair work in the areas of Vadapalani, Saligramam, Saligramam Kitangu, Valasaravakkam, Alwar Thirunagar, Karambakkam, and Alapakkam.

Arcot Road in the Valasaravakkam area has been damaged due to overflowing sewer water, occasional rains, and other departmental works on the roadside. CMWSSB and Larsen & Toubro are working together to clean the sewage water that fills the Manhole.

In addition to road repair work, road levelling works will also be carried out on Arcot Road from Kodambakkam to Porur. The contractor has also started the work of replacing the barricades near the end of the metro rail pillar works.

The CMRL has assured commuters that the repair work will be completed as soon as possible, and that they will do their best to minimize any inconvenience caused.

Commuters Advised to Plan Their Travel in Advance: Commuters are advised to plan their travel in advance during the period of the road repair works. There may be traffic restrictions in some areas, and commuters may experience delays.
