



Meeting Conducted for Preliminary Works on the Implementation of Metro Rail Project in Coimbatore



On December 24, 2024 a meeting was convened at the Fairfield by Marriott Hotel in Coimbatore to discuss the implementation of the Metro Rail project in Coimbatore city.

During the discussion, it was highlighted that the Government of Tamil Nadu has decided to implement a metro rail system in Coimbatore city to reduce traffic congestion and meet future travel needs. The proposed Coimbatore Metro Rail project spans 34.8 km and an estimated cost of ₹10,740 crore, with two corridors & 32 stations. The Detailed Project Report (DPR) for the Phase 1 of Coimbatore Metro Rail has been submitted to Government of India and is under review.

Preliminary works have begun for expediting the metro project procedures and minimize the inconvenience to the public during the implementation.

Future expansions, including extensions to Mettupalayam and Trichy Road, are under consideration. The proposed metro stations will integrate key public transport hubs such as airport, railway station, and bus terminals.

This integrated initiative also includes a similar metro rail proposal for Madurai, with an estimated cost of **₹11,340 crore**, which has been submitted along with Coimbatore Metro project for Government of India's approval.

CONTRACT AWARDED FOR ELECTRICAL AND MECHANICAL SYSTEMS IN CORRIDOR 5 OF CHENNAI METRO PHASE 2 PROJECT.



On December 13, 2024, CMRL signed a contract with M/s Jakson Limited for Electrical and Mechanical Systems of Corrridor 5, encompassing the supply, installation, testing, commissioning and training of electrical, plumbing, fire Protection, VAC works & BMS system for 6 Underground Stations, 10 Elevated Stations including Bored Tunnel and Elevated Viaduct from Madhavaram Milk Colony Station to Koyembedu 100 Feet Road Station for a value of Rs. 168.16 Crores.

AN INSPIRING JOURNEY FOR GOVERNMENT SCHOOL STUDENTS




