Punishment for affixing posters and bills **on CMRL structures**

It is found that posters and bills are pasted in structures of Chennai Metro Rail Limited. Unauthorized affixing of Posters, bills, etc., on the Chennai Metro Rail structures such as piers, barricades and other structures being constructed under Chennai Metro Rail Project is an illegal act. Such actions are offences under section 3-A and 4-A of the Tamil Nadu Open Places (Prevention of Disfigurement) Act, 1959 read with sections 425, 431 and 434 of I.P.C., punishable with imprisonment either description for a term which may extend to five years or fine which may extend to five thousand rupees or with both. Chennai Metro Rail Limited will take stern action against the offenders indulging in disfigurement of Chennai Metro Rail Structures.

Hence, those who are indulging in such activities are warned by Chennai Metro Rail Limited to refrain from doing so. Public are requested to cooperate.
