CONTRACT AGREEMENT SIGNED FOR CONSTRUCTION OF FIVE (05) UNDERGROUND STATIONS IN CORRIDOR 5 FOR A VALUE OF RS. 1817.54 CR ON OCTOBER 13, 2023

Chennai Metro Rail Limited signed the Contract Agreement for Contract No. C5-CP06-UG-06 with M/s TATA Projects Limited on October 13, 2023. The letter of Acceptance (LOA) issued to M/s TATA Projects Limited for Tender No. CMRL/CON/PHASE 2/CORR-5/CP06/UG06-RT01/2021 on September 11, 2023 for a value INR 1817.54 Cr (Including Provisional Sum & GST). This is a JICA funded tender. The scope of work involves Construction of Five (05) Underground Stations at Kolathur Junction Metro, Srinivasa Nagar Metro, Villivakkam Metro (Near Sub-urban), Villivakkam Bus Terminus Metro and Villivakkam MTH Road Metro with Entry / Exit, Ventilation Shafts, Plumbing, Earthmat, Architectural Finishes & Signages Etc. including Twin Bored Tunnels from Kolathur Junction Retrieval Shaft to Villivakkam MTH Road Launching Shaft and Ramps with U – Section in Corridor-5 of CMRL Phase 2 Project.

In the presence of Thiru. **M.A.Siddique**, I.A.S., Managing Director of CMRL, the Contract Agreement was signed by **Thiru. T.Archunan**, IRSE – Director (Projects) on behalf of CMRL and **Thiru. Raman Kapil** - Executive Vice President on behalf of M/s TATA Projects Limited. **Thiru. T. Livingstone Eliazer**, CGM (PP&D), **Tmt.Rekha Prakash**, CGM (PD), **Thiru. D. Gurunath Reddy**, AGM (CP), Senior Officials from CMRL, GC & Contractor were present during the Occasion. With the award of UG06, CMRL has achieved 100% completion of the award of Civil & track contracts for Phase 2 project comprising a 116.1 km metro network in three corridors.

PASSENGER TRAFFIC RECORDS STEADY GROWTH IN OCTOBER, 2023 IN CHENNAI METRO RAIL OVER 85.50 LAKH PASSENGERS TRAVELLED DURING THE MONTH OF OCTOBER



October 20, 2023 recorded the highest passenger flow for the month, with 3,60,743 passengers.

In the month of October, 2023 a total of 34,20,155 passengers have utilised the QR Code ticketing system (Online QR – 2,07,097; Static QR – 96,913; Paper QR – 25,52,323; Paytm – 3,53,003; Whatsapp – 2,10,819), 42,16,831 passengers have used Travel Card Ticketing System, 2,51,955 passengers have used Token System, 7,928 passengers have used Group Ticketing System and 6,53,161 passengers have used *NCMC Singara Chennai Card*.

SWIFT ROAD REPAIR INITIATIVES, ALONGSIDE ONGOING CHENNAI METRO RAIL WORKS, COMMENCED FROM OCTOBER 27, 2023

Construction work on the Phase 2 project of the Chennai Metro Rail is progressing vigorously at various locations, including Poonamallee Highway, Madhavaram Highway, Tiruvottiyur Highway, Arcot Road, and Medavakkam-Perumbakkam Road.

Presently, 75% of the road construction has been accomplished with 3.7 km of road laid between Poonamallee and Porur Highway. 87% of the road work on the Arcot Road has been successfully executed, encompassing 11.6 km of road. Similarly, a 2 km stretch of Medavakkam road has been completed, signifying the completion of 65% of the road re-laying work.

Efforts are underway to keep the roads accessible to vehicles. Repair work on potholes and damaged roads in Tiruvottiyur Road, Madhavaram, and OMR Highway is finished. The damaged roads near ongoing CMRL construction sites are being promptly repaired. CMRL is also working diligently to ensure all roads are prepared for the upcoming monsoon season.

RENOVATION OF THE CAR PARKING AREA AT THE LITTLE MOUNT METRO STATION WAS STARTED ON OCTOBER 26, 2023



In an effort to enhance passenger convenience and optimise parking operations, we are starting the renovation of the car parking area at the Little Mount Metro Station.

To facilitate these works, the parking area was temporarily closed for a period of two months, commencing on November 1, 2023. During this closure, all passengers are requested to utilise the car parking facilities available at adjacent metro stations.
