










TBM Podhigai (S97) Breakthrough at Madhavaram High Road on November 2, 2023

Chennai Metro Rail Limited expanded the city's metro network in Phase II after completing Phase I and Phase I Extension Corridors. JICA, ADB, AIIB, and NDB contributed funding to the project, which involved three corridors spanning 116.1 km. Corridor 3, which extends 45.4 km from Madhavaram Milk Colony to Siruseri - Sipcot, runs from north to south and has 28 underground and 19 elevated stations.

TThe tunnel construction for the initial 9 km underground section of Corridor 3 from Madhavaram Milk Colony to Kellys is being executed through **M/s.Tata Projects Limited**, mobilising 7 TBM's* for the works. The TBM Podhigai (S97) tunnel drive started on 18.01.2023, from Madhavaram Milk Colony Station to Madhavaram High Road, covering a bored tunnel length of 1.4 km and breaking through at Madhavaram High Road on 02.11.2023. Officials and staff of CMRL, GC, and Tata Projects were present during the event.

TBM – Tunnel Boring Machine - A tunnel boring machine, also known as a "Mole", is a machine used to excavate tunnels. Tunnels are excavated through hard rock, wet or dry soil, or sand, each of which requires specialized technology.





PHONEPE TICKETING SERVICE NOW AVAILABLE FOR CHENNAI METRO RAIL COMMUTERS

CMRL has partnered with Phonepe to launch Digital QR-based ticketing for metro travellers. Passengers can book tickets on the PhonePe Switch platform, with a 20% discount. The system was launched on November 17, 2023, at MetroS, Nandanam, Anna Salai.

The primary objective was to enable the booking of single-trip tickets, with the other two services soon to follow. The convenience of obtaining e-tickets for up to six people from a single device makes it easy for commuters to enter and exit Metro stations smoothly.




Corporation to ensure that the city was well-prepared for the Monsoon season. CMRL was committed to the safety and well-being of its passengers and the public.
