2.53 crore passengers travelled in Chennai Metro Rail in 2021

CMRL commenced its Metro Train operations from 29th June 2015 and has become the lifeline for the people of Chennai. This can very well be seen in the monumental increase in the patronage in 2021 wherein 2.53 crore passengers travelled in Chennai Metro.

In addition, CMRL witnessed a monumental increase in its ridership since the commencement of Metro Train Operations in 2015.

- 2,80,52,357 passengers travelled between 29th June 2015 to 31st December 2018.
- 3,28,13,628 passengers travelled between 1st January 2019 to 31st December 2019.
- 1,18,56,982 passengers travelled between 1st January 2020 to 31st December 2020
- 2,53,03,383 passengers travelled between 1st January 2021 to 31st December 2021.

So far, a total of **9,80,26,350** passengers have travelled in Chennai Metro between 29th June 2015 to 31st December 2021.

Metro Train services were suspended from March 2020 - September 2020 and from May 2021 – June 2021 due to the COVID-19 pandemic lockdown.
