Madhavaram Metro Train Depot being constructed at a cost of Rs.284.51 crore

Thiru. M.A. Siddique, Managing Director of CMRL, inspected Madhavaram Depot site, which is being built at a cost of Rs. 284.51 crores on an area of 48.89 acres as part of the Chennai Metro Rail Project Phase-II.

The Madhavaram Depot is being built to accommodate 110 metro trains, each with three coaches. A total of 24 track lines are being built, including 10 for the stabling yard, 7 for the workshop bay and deep clean bay, and 7 for the inspection bay. On these tracks, 110 metro trains can be stopped. In addition, a 1.4-kilometer test track line will be built.

The Depot will be used for metro train maintenance and cleaning. The Madhavaram Depot construction is expected to be completed by the end of 2024. CMRL's Managing Director stated this during a visit to the Madhavaram Depot.
