A Gigantic National Flag flies 24 hours a day at the head office of the CMRL, MetroS

Chennai Metro Rail Limited celebrated the Independence Day of India at CMRL MetroS, Anna Salai, Nandanam, today (15.08.2023). Thiru. M.A. Siddique, I.A.S., Principal Secretary / Managing Director of CMRL hoisted the National Flag and accepted the parade salute.

Following this, a 60 feet (20 metre) long flag pole with a National Flag measuring 18 feet (5.48 meters) wide and 12 feet (3.68 meters) long in front of the MetroS was hoisted. The flag was inaugurated at the METROS campus by MD, CMRL Thiru. M.A. Siddique I.A.S., on August 15, 2023.

The National Flag fully Motorised system for hoisting and dehoisting. The flag will be flown day and night. Necessary LeD's are installed to light the flag at night with automatic timer control. Lightning arrestor and aviation lights are installed at the apex point of the pole. Dedicated team is specially deputed to operate and maintain the flag as per the flag code of India 2002. The tricolor flag size is as per the flag code of India 2002 (3:2 ratio). The flag pole is erected on a stepped granite podium with landscaping.

The Chennai Metro Rail Limited has hoisted a Gigantic National Flag in Celebration of India's Independence Day today (15.08.2023), similar to the great National Flag at Chennai Central Railway Station and Airport.
