Proposed Salient features of Detailed Feasibility Reports (DFR) for recommending MRTS from Poonamalle to Parandur via Thirumazhisai & Sriperumbudur is as follows.

Total length Corridor: 43.63 km

Tentative No. of Elevated Stations: 19Nos

Approximate estimated Completion cost: Rs 10,712 Cr

CMRL recommended the above considering the recent developments such as the proposed New Airport at Parandur, proposed Bus Terminus at Thirumazhisai and future growth potential along the Corridor. Following extensive alignment study at the DPR stage, the total number of stations and details of land requirements will be finalized.
