Contract Agreement Signed for Reassessment of Travel Demand Forecasting Study for implementing Mass Rapid Transit System from Tambaram to Velachery extending to either Guindy or Little Mount

Chennai Metro Rail Limited signed the Contract Agreement for “Providing Consultancy Services towards Reassessment of Travel Demand Forecasting Study for implementing Mass Rapid Transit System from Tambaram to Velachery extending to either Guindy or Little Mount and updating the existing DFR” with M/s SYSTRA MVA Consulting (India) Pvt. Ltd on 05/03/2024.

The scope of work involves preparation of Travel Demand Forecasting Study for implementing Mass Rapid Transit System between Tambaram and Velachery, extending to either Guindy or Little Mount for a 26 km corridor. As per the earlier DFR submitted to GoTN, the corridor was considered only up to Velachery MRTS station and did not consider connection to existing Metro stations through main commercial and residential areas of Velachery. Hence the re-assessment of Travel Demand Forecasting study is being undertaken.
