

WHATSAPP TICKETING SERVICE LAUNCHED



Chennai Metro Rail Limited (CMRL) launched its own WhatsApp chatbot-based QR ticketing service on May 17, 2023, aiming to make daily commuting more efficient and seamless for Chennai commuters. The chatbot is available in English and Tamil and allows users to book tickets, check fares, and select starting and destination stations.

The service is available in English and Tamil and is available for all Chennai Metro commuters. Thiru. M.A. Siddique, I.A.S., Managing Director, CMRL, stated that the WhatsApp chatbot offers a faster and easy digital solution for passengers, saving time and eliminating long queues.

The service also includes a 20% discount. The terms and conditions of the WhatsApp Ticketing service include generating QR tickets for single journey and group tickets up to a maximum of 6, validity after the business day, and exiting at the source station within 20 minutes. Ticket bookings cannot be made after business hours, and cancellations are not allowed.

Larsen & Toubro Limited for an amount of Rs.533.87 Crores

CMRL/PHASE-II/SYS/CP20.2-OHE-07/2021 FOR RS.239.41 CRORES TO M/S. LARSEN & TOUBRO LTD.

To provide reliable OHE for Corridor 3 which is total length of 35.043 km & Corridor 5 which is total length of 16.16 km. The total track km of Madhavaram depot is 21.0 km. CMRL awarded the tender for the design, manufacturing, supply, installation, testing, training, and commissioning of OHE & switching stations for CMRL Phase II, covering Corridor 3 and Corridor 5. The tender was awarded to M/s. Larsen & Toubro Limited for Rs.239.41 Crores.

The contract agreements were signed by Thiru. Rajesh Chaturvedi, Director (Systems and Operations), CMRL and Thiru. Sunil Khattar, Vice President & Head-Metro Business Unit, Larsen & Toubro Limited on May 24, 2023 at MetroS, Nandanam, Chennai. FACTORY ACCEPTANCE TEST OF 2ND TUNNEL BORING MACHINE FOR CORRIDOR 4, UG 01

CMRL's ambitious Phase II for a network of 118.9 km is a gargantuan feat undertaken at one stretch and a first of its kind in India with 119 stations in three corridors.

Corridor-4 (From Light House to Poonamalee Bypass) – 26.1 KM. Chennai Metro Rail Limited (CMRL) has been implementing the construction of underground metro rail project corridor 4 from Light House Station at Marina Beach to Kodambakkam Flyover. The underground section of this corridor is split into two packages (UG-01 & UG-02) each of which contains 4 KM of twin tunnels. In order to complete the approximately 16KM of tunnelling, four Tunnel Boring Machines (TBM) have been proposed to execute the entire tunnelling of approximately 16 KM considering both Upline & Downline tunnels.

These Tunnel Boring Machines manufactured by reputable German company M/s Herrenknecht, a pioneer in the production of TBMs for various types of the tunneling needs, will be used by CMRL's contractor M/s ITD Cementation India Limited.

The Factory Acceptance Test of 3rd Tunnel Boring Machine of the corridor which is 2nd TBM for UG-01 package is successfully done in presence of CMRL's officials and various officers from General Consultants, M/s AEON Consortium at HK factory in Thiruvallur District, Ponneri Thaluk, Alinjivakkam village, Chennai.

The name of this Tunnel Boring Machine is Flamingo (S1352A) which is a 6.670 M bore diameter and 110 m long Earth Pressure Balance Machine. The total weight of this machine is approximately 700 MT which will now be dismantled in parts, packed and transported to its destination at Light House Station, Marina Beach. The construction of the TBM launching Shaft is under progress at Light House Station and is expected to be ready to lower and assemble the TBM in the month of August 2023.

This TBM will be launched in Downline of this corridor-4 and will mine at a maximum depth of 29 m below ground starting from Light House, Kutchery Road, Thirumaylai, Alwarpet, Bharatidasan and finally scheduled to arrive at Boat Club in Nov 2025.
