CONTRACT AWARDED FOR ELECTRICAL AND MECHANICAL SYSTEMS IN CORRIDOR 5
OF CHENNAI METRO PHASE 2



On March 5, 2024, CMRL made key developments in its Phase 2 project by signing a contract for Electrical and Mechanical Systems of Corridor 5, encompassing the supply, installation, testing, commissioning, and training of electrical, fire protection, and VAC works for 22 elevated stations. The contract was awarded to M/s Universal MEP Projects & Engineering Services Limited for a total value of Rs. 137.86 Crores.

The contract agreement was signed by Thiru. Rajesh Chaturvedi, Director (Systems and Operations), CMRL, and Thiru. Single journey tickets priced at a flat fare of Rs. 50 were issued at these counters, allowing commuters to exit at any metro station.
