



## **Offences & Penalties - Metro Rail O&M Act 2002**

1	59	Drunkness or creating nuisance on Metro railway	Fine of Rs.500/- + forfeiture of fare or shall be removed from carriage.
2	60	Taking or causing to take offensive material upon metro railway	Fine up to Rs.500/- + shall be responsible for any loss or injury or damage to Metro Railway
3	61	Taking or causing to take dangerous material upon metro railway	Imprisonment up to 4 years + Fine up Rs.5,000/- + shall be responsible for any Loss or injury or damage to Metro Railway.
4	62	Demonstration of any kind upon Metro Railway (Premises)/ Pasting posters, writing or drawing anything in the compartment or carriage (premises)/For refusal to Leave.	Shall be liable to penalty which may extend to five thousand rupees (Rs.5000/-) and shall also be liable to be removed from the train by any metro railway official authorized by the metro railway administration in this behalf.
5	63	Travelling on roof etc. of a train	Imprisonment up to 1 months or Fine up Rs.50/- or with both + removal from train.
6	64	Unlawfully entering or remaining upon metro railway	Imprisonment up to 3 months or Fine up Rs.250/- or with both
		walking on metro track without lawful authority	Imprisonment up to 6 months or fine up Rs.500/- or with both
7	67	Obstructing running of train or rolling stock etc.	Imprisonment up to 4 years or Fine up Rs.5000/- or with both
8	68	Obstructing metro railway official in his duties	Imprisonment up to 1 years or Fine up Rs.1000/- or with both

9	69	Travelling without proper pass or ticket or beyond authorized distance	1. Ordinary single fare for the distance travelled or ordinary single fare from the station from which the train originally started by. 2. Difference between any fare paid and the fare payable in respect of the journey made+ Rs.50/- 3. the excess charge and any difference of fare mentioned in sub-section (2), fails or refuses to pay the same on a demand being made therefor, any metro railway official authorized by the metro railway administration in this behalf may apply to any Metropolitan Magistrate or, as the case may be, Judicial Magistrate of the first class, for the recovery of the sum payable as if it were a fine."
10	70	Interfacing with means of communication in train or Misuse of Alarm Bell	shall be liable to penalty which may extend to ten thousand rupees (Rs.10,000/-)
11	71	Altering or defacing or counterfeiting pass or ticket.	Imprisonment for 6 months.
12	72	Defacing Public notice	Imprisonment up to 2 months or fine of Rs.250/- or with both
13	73	Unauthorized sale of Articles	Rs.500/- and in default to pay Fine Imprisonment up to 6 months.
14	74	1. Maliciously wrecking a train or causing sabotage 2. Sabotage with intent to cause death or bodily injury likely to cause death.	1. Imprisonment for life or Rigorous Imprisonment for 10 years. 2. Death penalty or imprisonment for life.
15	75	Unauthorized sale of ticket.	Imprisonment up to 3 months or Fine upto Rs.500/- or with both + forfeiture of tickets.

16	76	Maliciously hurting or attempting to hurt persons traveling by Metro Railways.	Imprisonment for life or Imprisonment up to 10 Years.
17	77	Endangering safety of persons travelling by metro railway by rash or negligent	Imprisonment up to 1 years or with Fine, or with both
18	78	Damage or Destruction of certain Metro Railway Properties.	Imprisonment up to 10 Years.
