TBM Anaimalai (S98) Breaks through at Otteri shaft in Corridor 3 from Madhavaram Milk colony to Siruseri Sipcot

Chennai Metro Rail Limited has commenced the expansion of the Chennai city's metro rail network as part of Phase II after the successful completion of the Phase I and Phase I Extension. CMRL has ventured into an extensive infrastructure development in the city comprising of three more corridors of metro rail for a total length of 116.1 km. A total of 23 TBM's (Tunnel Boring Machine) will be utilized in the tunnelling works for Phase 2 project.

In Corridor 3, the first 9 kilometers of the underground section, stretching from Madhavaram Milk Colony to Kellys is being executed through M/s Tata Projects limited. A total of 7 TBM's have been mobilized for the tunnelling works.

One of the TBM Anaimalai (S98) commenced its tunnel drive on 23.10.2023 from Ayanavaram Station to Otteri station (Down line) in Corridor 3 covered a bored tunnel length of 925 m and the TBM successfully reached its destination with a breakthrough at the Otteri shaft.
