CMRL Expands Parking Amenities at Arignar Anna Alandur Metro Station for Enhanced Passenger Comfort

A newly renovated parking area, located on other side of the station behind MGR Statue has been upgraded with paver blocks and can now accommodate an additional 300 two-wheelers.
