RENAMING OF NANGANALLUR METRO STATION TO "OTA – NANGANALLUR ROAD METRO STATION"

Chennai Metro Rail Limited is pleased to announce the renaming of Nanganallur Metro Station to OTA — Nanganallur Road Metro as per Government Order - G.O.Ms.No.151 dated 22.10.2024. The OTA — Nanganallur Road Metro station is part of the Blue Line of Phase-1 stretch of the CMRL project. The renaming of the station serves as a significant tribute to the Indian Army, recognizing the pivotal role of the Officers Training Academy (OTA) located near the Metro Station.
