Travel Seamlessly to "Vijay Antony 3.0 - Live in Concert" with Sponsored Metro Passes

Chennai Metro Rail Limited (CMRL) is thrilled to announce its collaboration with M/s Noise & Grains Private Limited to enhance the travel experience for attendees of the highly anticipated "Vijay Antony 3.0 - Live in Concert, Chennai." The concert has been rescheduled to 18th January 2025 (Saturday), and the venue has been changed to YMCA College Grounds, Nandanam from the previously planned location at the AM Jain College Grounds, Meenambakkam.

Sponsored Metro Travel for Concert Goers

As part of this partnership, concert attendees who have booked their tickets through "Insider" or "District" platforms will receive exclusive sponsored digital unique Metro passes. These passes will allow attendees to enjoy a round-trip journey between their nearest Metro Station and Nandanam Metro Station for a seamless and stress-free travel experience.

The digital Metro passes feature unique QR codes that can be scanned at Automatic Gates across Chennai Metro stations, providing effortless entry and exit. Each Metro pass is valid for one round trip (two entries and two exits) on the day of the event.

Previously issued Sponsored Metro Passes for the original event date 18th December, 2024 are no longer valid. Only the newly issued sponsored metro passes will be accepted.

Special Metro Train Services for Concert Night -

To accommodate concert attendees, the last train from Nandanam Metro Station will depart at 00:15 Hrs. towards Wimco Nagar Depot and towards Airport Metro Station.

Passenger Interchange Options:

 Passengers traveling to Green Line stations (Ekkattuthangal, Ashok Nagar, Vadapalani, Arumbakkam, Puratchi Thalaivi Dr. J. Jayalalithaa CMBT Metro, Koyambedu, Thirumangalam, Anna Nagar Tower, Anna Nagar East, Shenoy Nagar, Pachaiyappa's College, Kilpauk, Nehru Park, and Egmore) can interchange at Puratchi Thalaivar Dr. M.G. Ramachandran Central Metro Station (Platforms 1 & 2).

- Passengers traveling to St.Thomas Mount can interchange at Arignar Anna Alandur Metro Station (Platform 3).
- Passenger entry into Nandanam Metro Station will close 10 minutes before the departure of the last train.

Parking Availability:

All metro stations are equipped with ample parking spaces for attendees' convenience. Standard parking charges will apply.
