TBM Peacock Breakthrough at Kodambakkam Ramp Retrieval Shaft



On July 23, 2025, CMRL marked a key milestone with the successful breakthrough of Tunnel Boring Machine "Peacock" (DL 1074) at the Kodambakkam Ramp Retrieval Shaft near Meenakshi College.

This TBM commenced its tunnel drive on May 2, 2024, from Panagal Park Station to Kodambakkam Power House Station on Corridor 4 between Light House and Poonamallee Bypass Metro. This TBM achieved a breakthrough, covering a tunnel length of 2.047 km, making it the longest tunnel in Phase 2, navigating beneath 190 buildings (including old buildings), active railway tracks, two churches, and the Kodambakkam flyover.

CMRL successfully energized 33 kV Auxiliary Substations at six more stations on Corridor 4



The following four stations Poonamallee Bypass, Poonamallee Bus Stand, Mullaithottam, and Karayanchavadi were already energized earlier.







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
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
