CMRL Signs Contract with Thomas Iyadurai Infrastructure Private Limited for Reconstruction of Bridge across Virugambakkam–Arumbakkam Canal

Chennai Metro Rail Limited (CMRL) has awarded the contract for the “Demolition and Reconstruction of the Bridge across the Virugambakkam–Arumbakkam Canal at Kaaliamman Kovil Street.” The project aims to enhance local connectivity and improve road infrastructure in the area.

The contract has been awarded to M/s Thomas Iyadurai Infrastructure Private Limited at a value of ₹12.31 Crore, with a completion period of 180 days.

The scope of work includes the construction of a new wider bridge matching with the existing four lane road. The upgraded bridge has been designed to support improved traffic movement, enhance road safety, and facilitate smoother connectivity between the surrounding residential and commercial areas.

Upon completion, the new bridge is expected to significantly improve accessibility and commuting convenience for the public, while also easing traffic flow in the locality.

The contract agreement was signed in the august presence of Thiru. T. Archunan, Director (Projects), CMRL, between Thiru. T. Livingstone Eliazer, Chief General Manager (PP&D), CMRL, and Thiru. R. Thomas Iyadurai, Managing Director, M/s Thomas Iyadurai Infrastructure Private Limited. Senior officials of CMRL, including CGM’s Dr. D. Jebaselwin Gladson (CP&M) and Tmt. Rekha Prakash (P&D), were present during the event.
